



What is Crossroads?

Crossroads is a non-profit corporation, which takes Hong Kong's quality excess goods and redistributes them to people in need, locally and internationally. Goods donated to Crossroads are distributed to organisations working hard to meet needs. These groups typically work with orphans, the elderly, the handicapped, refugees, disaster victims and those with educational, financial or medical needs.

What will we do at Crossroads?

We will participate in a life x-perience simulation called 'Refugee Run'. This is an intense and very powerful simulation where participants face simulated attacks, mine fields where they may be 'injured', life in a refugee camp, hunger, illness, lack of education, corruption and uncertain shelter or safety. Participants may also be marched under guard, subjected to ambush and, ultimately, offered a chance of re-settlement where they must re-build their lives.

Thereafter, we will have lunch and shop at the Marketplace. A number of the items in the marketplace are made by refugees, which will be a good gift for friends and family.

What is the proposed schedule?

Timetable for Saturday 29 November

9.30am	For those will utilise SA-provided transportation, meet at Central Pier No. 9 for bus pick-up
10.15am	For those who will travel there on their own, meet us at the gates of Crossroads. Free parking is available. Crossroads' address and a location map can be found on their website
10.30am - 1pm	Refugee Run experience
1pm - 2pm	Lunch (feel free to bring your own food or eat at one of the restaurants / cafes around)
2 pm - 3 pm	Shopping at the Marketplace
3pm onwards	Depart on your own (Bus no. 962 goes straight to Central)

How much will it cost?

If you utilise the SA-provided transportation, SA will split the cost with you at the end of the bus journey. Otherwise, you do not have to pay for your visit to Crossroads. As Crossroad is a charitable organisation, please feel free to donate to them and / or purchase items at the Marketplace.
